Children in Need Spotacular

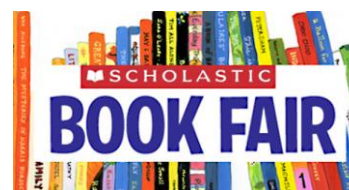
