This term in Maths we are completing our work on addition and subtraction before moving on to money. We will also be encouraging the children to learn their 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table through regular practice. Any practice you can do at home will be a great support to their learning.

English

Our English focus this term will be to create a story based upon the wonderful tale 'Stardust by Jeanne Willis'. We will be exploring feelings and thinking about what makes us special, before writing our own story about overcoming a problem. We will also continue with our weekly spelling test.

Topic

Our topic this term is Street Detectives. We will be investigating the history and geography of Stamford and creating a report on what we love about our town.



Music

This term's song is called Ho Ho Ho! The children will be learning to perform the song through sign language and will also be writing their own Christmas-themed rap!
