Personal Social and Emotional Development

- EYFS & Year 1s will be Looking at family meal times, traditions and favourite foods
- Learning to play in a group with other children and listen to others
- 5 ways to wellbeing – keeping our minds and bodies healthy

Expressive Arts and Design

- Sketch, draw and shade still life drawings of fruit and vegetables
- Using a range of materials to design and make products



Maths

- Exploring shapes and spatial awareness
- Estimating, representing and comparing numbers to 5 and beyond
- Year 1s will be looking at addition, subtraction and comparing and number bonds to 10 and beyond

Literacy

- Looking at traditional tales
- Learning Read Write Inc. set 1 speed sounds
- Learning sounds blending through 'Fred Talk'
- Write captions and labels
- Year 1s will be looking at story sequencing and punctuation and developing independent writing skills

Understanding the World

- Year 1s will be gathering and recording data to help answer questions
- Learning about how what our body needs to stay healthy
- Exploring where we live
- Looking at seasonal changes

R.E./Come and See

- Our topic this term will be Advent, Christmas and Loving - we will be looking at how we prepare for Jesus' birth
- We will also learn about Judaism

Physical Development

- Developing competence in a range of sports activities
- Year 1s will be learning about team building
- EYFS will be learning the fundamentals of P.E. in addition to developing gross and fine motor skills

Homework

- All children will bring home 2 books-a reading book, a sharing book and lambs will bring a 'sounds' book to practise at home
- Year 1s will be given spellings, maths and English homework once a week, focusing on what we have been learning at school
