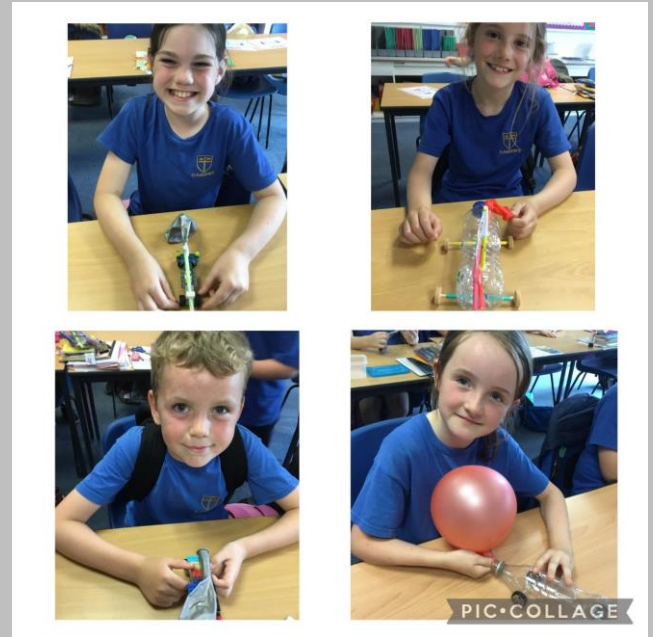
The house captains

The final amount raised from the summer fayre last week was a fantastic £181! Well done everyone!







Transition Day: Tuesday 6th July

Attendance

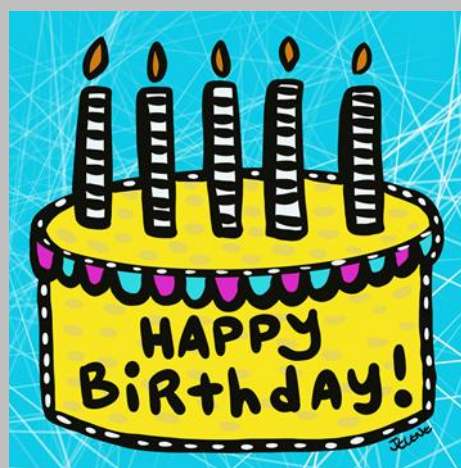
The highest attendance this week was Eagles class again with 98% attendance so they will have 5 minutes extra playtime next week!
