Personal Social and Emotional Development

- Continuing to play in groups with other children, sharing toys and taking turns
- Focusing on managing our feelings and behaviour
- Continuing with our 5 ways to wellbeing, keeping our minds and bodies healthy
- Life to the full – hand made with love, role models and friendship

Expressive Arts and Design

- To use drawing and painting to share ideas, experiences and imagination paying attention to details
- Designing models, selecting materials and resources to construct them



Maths

- EYFS will begin our new phase of counting to 20 and beyond looking at number patterns, estimating and addition and subtraction with numbers to 20
- Year 1s will be looking at multiplication and division – counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s
- Exploring arrays and making equal groups

Literacy

- Our key texts this term will be: Goldilocks and the Three Bears, Owl Babies, When I was young and The Paper Dolls
- Continuing to learn Read Write Inc. set 1, 2 and 3 speed sounds
- Writing captions, labels and simple sentences
- Year 1s will be continuing to develop their independent writing skills

Understanding the World/Science/Geography/History

- Observing objects/materials/living things and changes over time including life cycles
- Year 1s will also be grouping and sorting objects/materials and living things based on specific features
- Changes within living memory, national life and transport across the ages
- Looking at seasonal changes from spring to summer

R.E./Come and See

- Our R.E. topic this term is Holidays, we will be learning about Ascension Day, the story of Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit - John 13:33; 14:18

Physical Development

- Developing skills and confidence with the balance bikes and larger play equipment
- EYFS – will be focusing on games, running, throwing and balancing, social cooperation and fair play
- Year 1s – will be learning to move at different speeds for varying distances

Homework

- All children will bring home 2 books-a reading book, a sharing book and lambs will bring the sounds worksheets they have been learning
- Year 1s will be given maths, English and spellings homework which will be set on a Monday and will need to be handed back in on Friday.
