With support, pupils can use differentiated cards to select a scripture linked to the theme. Adults to model how to find scripture in the bible. With support, pupils to generate their own gather, response, word and mission according to the theme - they may use songs, actions, prayers, classroom resources within the liturgy. Adults support pupils in setting up a prayer focus with items linked to the theme. Pupils can use cards or an online bible resource confidently to select a scripture linked to the theme. Pupils can navigate the bible to find a specific passage in Bible. Pupils to generate their own gather, response, word and mission according to the theme - they may use songs, actions, prayers, classroom resources within the liturgy. Pupils can set up a prayer focus independently with items linked to the theme. Pupils are encouraged to give reasons for their choices e.g. prayer items, responses and recommendations. Adults should encourage increasing levels of independence throughout the planning process. The ultimate goal is for pupils to be fully independent in planning and delivering their liturgy. Ideally, adults should be present to oversee and only provide support when necessary.	Pupils to evaluate child-led liturgy using the KS2 NDCYS evaluation sheet. Pupils evaluating should ask questions to leaders about how their CW links with theme/scripture and what the impact of the CW will be going forward.
