

School Uniform

MAIN UNIFORM

- School navy cardigans, jumpers, navy sweatshirts and polo shirts must be bought from Shotbowl to include the school logo.
- Shotbowl is the school's appointed supplier of school uniform and supplies all items required, both with and without logos.
- If parents choose to purchase uniform from a supplier other than Shotbowl, those items must match in style and colour the items supplied by Shotbowl.
- Summer dresses must be a navy gingham pattern, not royal or sky blue and should not have a white collar. Play suit options can be worn.
- Socks must be plain grey or plain black if shorts are being worn, and socks and tights must be navy if a skirt is being worn. If summer dress uniform is being worn, socks must be plain navy or plain white. Socks should not have sports logos on them, even if they are the correct colour.
- School shoes must be smart and black (no trainers). No heels, fashion shoes or boots sensible black school shoes only. In summer, children should not wear open-toed sandals.
- Y6 children will be offered the opportunity to buy a leavers hoodie during the autumn terms. These can be worn from delivery until the end of the academic year except when representing the school at internal or external events, for example, choir performances and sporting events.

PE UNIFORM

- All children must have the full PE kit to include school royal blue t-shirts and royal blue sweatshirts, bought from Shotbowl to include the school logo, together with plain navy shorts, joggers.
- · Children to wear trainers with their PE kit.
- Children wear PE kits to school on PE days.
- If parents choose to purchase uniform from a supplier other than Shotbowl, those items must match in style and colour the items supplied by Shotbowl.

ACCESSORIES

- Hair accessories must be small, simple and plain in navy blue, white or to match hair colour.
- Hair accessories should not include flowers, large bows or overly decorative headbands.
- Extreme hairstyles and/or unnatural colours are not permitted.
- Earrings must be simple studs.
- Wristbands, bracelets and necklaces are not permitted (unless for medical reasons).
- All children must have a coat with them for winter and a sun hat for summer.
- Children must have a rucksack or book bag.
- Children in Y3-6 must have shin guards for football.
- If your child has pierced ears, they must be able to safely remove or tape over the earrings for PE.
- Long hair must be tied back for sports events and PE.
- Football boots with studs are not permitted at lunchtimes.



School Uniform

NAMED UNIFORM

- All uniform including shoes must be clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Named uniform will be returned to your child should it become lost.
- Unnamed lost property items will be donated to FoSA on a regular basis if the owner cannot be identified.

KS1 & KS2 - STANDARD/EVENTS UNIFORM

Navy sweatshirt or cardigan (with logo).

Royal blue polo shirt.

Charcoal grey zip front box pleat pinafore/ skirt or charcoal grey trousers.

Plain navy tights or socks if a skirt is being worn.

Plain grey or plain black socks if shorts or trousers are being worn. Socks should not have sports logos on them, even if they are the correct colour. Black shoes.

KS1 & KS2 - SUMMER UNIFORM - MAY TO OCTOBER

Navy (not royal blue or sky blue)/white classic style gingham summer dress with plain navy or plain white ankle socks. Socks should not have sports logos on them, even if they are the correct colour.

Charcoal grey classic shorts with grey or black ankle socks with the royal blue school polo shirt.

Black shoes.
